

JOINT CONFERENCE 1972

RHEOLOGY OF LUBRICANTS

FOR THIS Conference, biological lubricants will be specifically treated as well as industrial lubricants. Section 4 has been set aside for this area of work, but other sections of the programme will also no doubt be of interest as being closely related.

Arrangements have been made for this joint Institute of Petroleum/Institute of Mechanical Engineers/British Society of Rheology meeting, 6-7 July 1972. Accommodation has been arranged at the Byron Hall, Shakespeare Street, Nottingham. The Hall comprises a lecture theatre/dining and bedroom/sports and games complex, all of which will be available to participants. There will be a Conference Dinner on the first evening.

It is planned to make preprints available prior to the Conference and to publish the proceedings in the autumn of 1972.

The main headings to be covered are:

- (1) The Rheology of Petroleum-based Lubricants.
- (2) The Rheology of Greases.
- (3) Bio-Lubricants.
- (4) Effect of Pressure on Viscosity of Lubricants.
- (5) New Concepts in Theoretical and Experimental Rheology.
