

### Recommended Abbreviations and Units in Hematology

In order to have a standardized format for reporting blood count results the International Committee for Standardization in Haematology has made the following recommendations, which have also been endorsed by the International Society of Haematology.

Haemoglobin	Hb	g/L
Haematocrit	Hct	(L/L)
Packed cell volume (Refers specifically to centrifugation method)	PCV	(L/L)
Red blood cells (Erythrocytes)	RBC	$\times 10^{12}$ /L
Mean (red) cell volume	MCV	f1
Mean (red) cell haemoglobin	MCH	pg
Mean (red) cell haemoglobin concentration	MCHC	g/L
White blood cells (Leucocytes)	WBC	$\times 10^9$ /L
Platelets (Thrombocytes)	Plt	$\times 10^9$ /L
Mean platelet volume	MPV	f1
Plateletcrit (Thrombocrit)	Pct	(L/L)
Reticulocytes	Retic	$\times 10^9$ /L
