MA in information studies

The MA in Information Studies is a part-time, post-experience, degree for information workers who wish to update their present skills and knowledge in this fast developing area. It is intended for people already working in an information environment, who wish to expand their range to encompass the newly-emerging areas in the organisation and management of knowledge, and for those already working in these areas who are looking for a more formal framework to amplify and extend their current activities.

The MA aims to provide an arena for students to develop their understanding as information professionals, and the ability to apply this understanding in an innovative manner in the work organisation.

Course structure

The course consists of a series of self-contained modules, made available over a two year period. Each module requires full-time attendance over a central five-day week of formal teaching, and includes preparatory and follow-up work carried out in students' own time.

The course culminates in a substantial final project which brings together the various module strands within a practical context. The project will normally be based in the work organisation on a topic agreed between the student, the employer and the Polytechnic.

Timespan: 2–5 years

Ten modules must be completed within four years (and may be completed within two years). The final project must be completed within five years of starting the course.

Entry requirements:

The normal entry requirements are an honours degree, together with appropriate experience in an information context. Students will normally be expected to support course work by current employment in an information environment.
