

Forthcoming meetings convened by the Conference of European Statisticians

Meeting on statistics of fauna and flora (Geneva, September 1984)

The meeting will review the work on classifications of fauna and flora as carried out or planned by various international organizations. The purpose of the review is to determine the need for an ECE statistical classification in the field. Furthermore, the meeting will be asked to identify methodological problems encountered in the compilation of statistics of fauna and flora.

Meeting on classifications of economic activities and of goods and services (Geneva, November 1984)

The meeting will review the work on the harmonization and revision of economic classifications and nomenclatures at the world level. In particular, the meeting will consider drafts of the revised International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) and a new Combined Trade/Production Goods Classification.

Meeting on statistics of solid wastes (Geneva, December 1984)

The Conference of European Statisticians decided to develop an ECE draft statistical classification of solid wastes. This meeting is the first to discuss that issue. Accordingly, the meeting is expected to provide general guidance to the development of the envisaged classification, including, if possible, a first breakdown at the most general level. Furthermore, it is expected that topics for further methodological work in the area of statistics of solid wastes will be identified at the meeting.
