NOTES ON SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The program was arranged so as to avoid concurrent sessions. Since the responses to the invitations were overwhelming, each presentation was limited to twenty minutes, followed by a discussion period of ten minutes.

All discussion remarks have been included in the printed Proceedings of the Conference. The discussions were recorded by tape during the sessions and the discussants edited the transcripts after the Conference.

The languages of the Conference were English, French and German.

The Proceedings, which will be published this year in book form by Pergamon Press and edited by Professor A. L. Copley, will be entitled: "Hemorheology. Proceedings of the First International Conference, University of Iceland, Reykjavik, 1966".
