Co-operation between Societies in Clinical Haemorheology

Dear Sirs

We are writing to state publicly that the policy of the International Society for Clinical Haemorheology is to co-operate with all other societies related to the field of Clinical Haemorheology. It will have become evident to yourselves and your readers that there will be two international meetings on the subject of Clinical Haemorheology in June and July of 1995, organised by the separate European and International Societies respectively. Regardless of the reasons for this situation, we believe that it should not be allowed to happen again in the future. We thus wish to take this opportunity to invite the European Society for Clinical Haemorheology to state its policy in this matter, and indeed, to begin discussions to avoid a division in our growing field of science.
