The book reports about the 11th annual Meeting of the German Society of Clinical Microcirculation and Hemorheology e.V. in Heidelberg 1992. The classical areas of the cerebral, coronary and peripheral disturbances of the blood flow have been reported in different age groups. 9 reports are dealing with changes of hemorheology and microcirculation of new-born infants. The prognostic meaning of an increased blood viscosity was discussed on 5 reports. On 4 reports, therapeutic effects of hemodilution and plasmapherese were shown. A special characteristic of this association is its dealing with 10 reports about Capillary microscopy and the Doppler-Sonography. The reports are documented along with figures, tables and literature references.
