Fourth International Joint Conference on Ambient Intelligence (AmI'13)
Dublin, Ireland, December 3rd–5th 2013

We want to invite you to participate to AmI-13 in Dublin. It brings together researchers and practitioners from industry and academia working in the field of technologies and applications of Ambient Intelligence. Ambient Intelligence represents a vision of the future where we shall be surrounded by invisible technological means, sensitive and responsive to people and their behaviors, deliver advanced functions, services and experiences. Ambient Intelligence combines concepts of ubiquitous technology, intelligent systems and advanced user interfaces putting the humans in the center of technological developments.

1. Keynotes

AmI-13 features an opening keynote talk by Dr. Ted Selker, Carnegie Mellon University, Silicon Valley. His talk will frame the Considerate System stance of social feedback to a user and will describe results from a variety of Considerate Research projects, with examples including systems supporting people in audio conference call communication, TV interactions, saving energy in the Sustainability Base Leeds Platinum building and Considerate Mobile phone reactions. A second keynote will be given by Prof. Martin G. Curley, Vice President, Intel Labs Director Europe. He will talk about Intel's AmI perspective. Further Prof. Ben Schouten, Department of Industrial Design, Eindhoven University of Technology will hold a keynote "Play and the Challenge of Ambient Intelligence".
