The article titled 'Fuzzy theory and method for evaluating the importance of college course teaching for future education' by Yuyang Liu et al. and the article titled 'Theory and method for evaluating the importance of college course teaching for future education: From virtual reality to metaverse' by Jiongjiong Fan were simultaneously under review with the journal, under different handling editors. After publication, it was discovered that the two articles exhibit unnaturally similar content. Consequently, both the editor-in-chief of the journal and the publisher have reached the decision to retract both papers. The publisher has updated the original online PDF of both articles with the word "RETRACTED" watermarked over every page of the article.
