

## Forthcoming meetings convened by the Conference of European Statisticians

### **Work session on registers and administrative records in social and demographic statistics (January 1995)**

Countries in the region will exchange experiences at this meeting on the large variety of registers and administrative records that are being used to produce statistics in fields such as education statistics, health statistics, pensions, families, housing, migration and population and housing censuses. They will also exchange experiences on the usefulness of these types of sources for statistical purposes.

### **Twenty-Fourth session of the working party on electronic data processing (Geneva, 21–24 February 1995)**

The working party will consider the following items: (i) impact of new technologies on statistical data processing; (ii) integration of statistical and geographical information systems; (iii) EDP applications in business registers; (iv) progress in statistical computing in countries in transition; and (v) experiences in the development and implementation of means of exchanging statistical information electronically.

### **Work session on statistics of women (March 1995)**

This meeting will review progress countries are making in developing techniques for the valuation of unpaid work, statistical measures of male-female occupational and pay differences, and statistical measures of gender differences in various occupational, entrepreneurial and governmental positions. The meeting is being organized jointly with INSTRAW.

### **Work session on population censuses (May 1995)**

The participants will assess the extent to which countries in the UN/ECE region have been able to comply in their most recent population census with the recommendations that the Conference of European Statisticians adopted for the 1990 round of censuses for countries in the UN/ECE region. That assessment will serve as a guide for drawing up a new set of recommendations for the 2000 round of censuses in the UN/ECE region. The meeting will be organized jointly with Eurostat.

**1995 plenary session of the Conference of European Statisticians (Geneva, June 1995)**

The 43rd plenary session of the Conference of European Statisticians will be attended by the presidents of the statistical offices of virtually all 54 member states of the UN/ECE and by the heads of the statistical services of most international organizations working in the region. The coordination of statistical work in the region will figure prominently on the agenda. The Conference will also discuss possibilities to describe statistically the effects of ongoing integration processes in the UN/ECE region.
