ILO Bulletin of Labour Statistics

The Bulletin of Labour Statistics of the International Labour Organisation is published quarterly, with Supplements in the intervening months. It presents monthly and quarterly series on employment, unemployment, hours of work, wages and consumer prices from national official statistics. The regular quarterly issues of the Bulletin usually include one or more articles of methodological interest in the area of labour statistics.

A separate edition of the Bulletin is published towards the end of each year with the results of the ILO October Inquiry, an annual survey of wages and hours of work in 159 occupations and of retail prices for 93 food items.

The majority of articles is written in English with a short summary in French and Spanish.
